Quality of writing	Very well structured, cohesive and coherent text; virtually error-free; varied and appropriate vocabulary. Disorganized text, with frequent errors that compromise understanding.
Creativity and presentation	Original work, very well organized, with excellent visual presentation and attention to detail.	Organized and careful work, with visible creative elements.	Simple presentation, with little creativity or limited organization.	Work that is uncared for, incomplete, or disorganized.
